SCHOOL BUS SCHEDULING AND ROUTING

School bus stops shall be located in areas along bus routes and designed to comply with state law regarding students' embarking and disembarking on major thoroughfares.

To the extent practicable, elementary (K-6) bus stops shall be placed in such a manner so that pupils will not walk farther than one-quarter (1/4) mile to their designated stops and secondary (7-12) bus stops shall be placed so that pupils will not be required to walk farther than one (1) mile to their designated stops.

Distances will be measured from the point where private driveways and/or roads intersect with town, county, state, or federally maintained roads to the nearest established bus stop.

School bus stops for after school activities will be placed at central locations along routes. Since these routes are streamlined, parents are encouraged to pick up their students at established stops.
