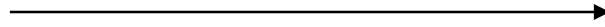

Adopt Bylaws, as measured by:
SAC Membership/Election,

- SAC Adopts Bylaws
- Three parent reps are *elected* by a vote of the parents of students enrolled in the school
- One teacher rep is *elected* by a vote of all licensed professionals
- Appointment* of a business person from the community, the school administrator, and representative from the parent organization
- No more than three members on the seven-member Council are employees of the school district
- Meeting calendar is established at the first meeting of the school year
- The meeting calendar reflects at least four meetings for the year
- The SAC follows the Open Meeting Law
