

**STATEWIDE AGREEMENT BETWEEN
DOUGLAS COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT and a COLORADO COLLEGE
HIGH SCHOOL CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT**

You have indicated that you are interested in enrolling in a college course while a high school student. The State of Colorado provides several options for high school students who meet high school standards to begin college early. The purpose of these options include promoting content standards, providing academic challenges, and providing access to academic courses that may not be available at a local high school to meet high school graduation requirements. All Colorado public four-year and two-year colleges, four vocational schools, and three private colleges participate in the following high school concurrent enrollment programs. *Terms are subject to change.

Each course must be 3 credits or more per course and earn a passing grade of a "C" or better to qualify for tuition. According to the law, school districts may voluntarily agree to pay for additional courses beyond two courses per term.)

SECTION D: Agreement: To be read and signed by student and student's parent/guardian

We understand that this agreement entitles my child to enroll in college courses. We understand the following:

- 1) The course is a college-level course (i.e., remedial instruction, pre-college level or P.E. courses are not eligible) and I will meet the same requirements as college students.
- 2) The student must sign up for the (COF) Colorado Opportunity Fund, register at the college and pay tuition and fees prior to the start of class.
- 3) The course satisfies college graduation requirements (note: physical education courses, remedial, basic skill courses, and advanced placement courses are not eligible under Fast Track or PSEO).
- 4) A letter grade of C or better allows the students to be reimbursed for tuition.
- 5) The grade earned will appear on both high school and college transcripts. Transferability is not guaranteed.
- 6) If I withdraw or receive a failing grade, reimbursement will not be available and students that have their bill pre-paid will reimburse the district within 30 days.
- 7) I am not eligible for the privileges of a college student, i.e., may not participate in college activities or sports, not eligible for federal or state-funded financial aid, including institutional scholarships funded with general fund dollars.
- 8) The application entitles me to enroll as a high school concurrent student and does not admit me into the college or a degree program.
- 9) I may be eligible for tuition reimbursement by the school district if I meet my district's requirements. Waived if (i) is checked in Section B.
- 10) Parent/student assumes all responsibility for transportation.
- 11) Request for tuition reimbursement must be made within 30 days after completion of course(s).
- 12) Application Deadline for each school year and term I'm attending is: April 4th – Fall Semester November 15th – Spring Semester

In signing this agreement, we have read it completely, and authorize the college to release student transcript to Douglas County School District at end of course.
