CSAP-A performance levels are: Inconclusive (IN), Exploring (EX), Emerging (EM), Developing (DE), and Novice (NO). The percentages of students at each level are shown for each group of 16 or more. An asterisk (*) indicates that the group contained fewer than 16 students.

The English Language Learners (ELL) group includes Non-English Proficient, Limited English Proficient, and Fluent English Proficient students whose native language is not English. Free or Reduced Meals (FRM) eligibility is based on family income.
