## Disapproving Ascent Classical Academy's Application for Use of School District Buildings and Land

WHEREAS, on November 1, 2017, Douglas County School District ("District") posted on the District's website a list of vacant and underused land and buildings available for the 2018-2019 school year in compliance with C.R.S. § 22-30.5-104(7.5)(a); and

WHEREAS, on May 7, 2018, Ascent Classical Academy ("Ascent") submitted a request to the District to use Eastridge, Toepfer Park, Ridgegate East, and Meridian Village (the "Vacant or Underused Properties") for its charter school during the 2018-2019 school year; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education ("Board") of the District has reviewed and considered Ascent's request.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Education of the Douglas County School District, Re.1 as follows:

- The Board disapproves of Ascent's request to use the Vacant or Underused Properties for the 2018-2019 school year because the timing of Ascent's request did not allow for the Long Range Planning Committee to review and assess the request for the purpose of making a recommendation to the Board.
- 2. The Board invites Ascent to re-apply for the use of vacant or underused buildings and property when the District posts the list of such properties for the 2019-2020 school year, no later than November 1, 2018.
