

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION  
OF  
DOUGLAS COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT RE-1  
ADOPTING THE COLORADO ACADEMIC STANDARDS

WHEREAS Colorado Revised Statutes (C.R.S.) § 22-7-1013(5) mandates that Colorado school districts review their elementary and secondary education standards on or before July 1, 2017;<sup>1</sup>

WHEREAS C.R.S. § 22-7-1013(5) permits a school district to “readopt its standards” so as to ensure that the standards “continue to meet or exceed the state preschool through elementary and secondary education standards”;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education affirms that, to provide clarity to the DCSD community, DCSD adopts the Colorado Academic Standards as its own.

Adopted this 11th day of July, 2017, by a vote of 7-0.

<sup>1</sup> The statutory language of C.R.S. 22-7-1013(5) reads: On or before July 1, 2017, and on or before July 1 every six years thereafter, each local education provider shall review its preschool through elementary and secondary education standards and, taking into account any revisions to the state preschool through elementary and secondary education standards, shall revise and readopt its standards if necessary to ensure that they continue to meet or exceed the state preschool through elementary and secondary education standards. The local education provider shall revise its curricula accordingly to ensure that the curricula continue to align with the local education provider’s preschool through elementary and secondary education standards.
