A charge action shall be a public, unascentrian, nonreligious, non-home-based school, subject to all federal and state laws and constitutional provisions probabiling discrimination on the basis of disability, race, creat, color, gender, national origin, religion, ancestry or need for special education services which operates within Douglas County School District Re. 1 and is accountable to the Board of Education. A district charter school has standing to sue and be such in its own name for the enforcement of any contract it is authorized by law to enter into Enrollment in a charter school shall be open to any child who resides within the Douglas County School District or in contiguous school districts and who meets the criteria in the district charter application. The majority of the district charter school shall not charge tuition except as otherwise provided by law.

A charter school proposal requires a written agreement between the charter school authors/organizers and Douglas County School District Re. 1, and must be authorized and approved by the Board of Education. Douglas County School District Re. 1 will follow a fair and consistent charter school proposal process. Establishing/monitoring/managing this process will be the responsibility of the Superintendem or designed.

The Douglas County School District RP. I believes and supports educating the while child. A charter school shall be a public nonsectarian, non-religious, non-home-based school, subject to all federal and state laws and constitutional provisions prohibiting distrimination on the base of disability, race, creed, color, gender, national origin, religion, ancestry or need for special advantion services which operates within Douglas County School District Re. 1 and is accountable to the Board of Education. A district charter school has standing to me and be sued in its own name for the coforcament of any contract it is authorized by law to enter into Eurobiment in a charter school shall be open to any child who resides within the Douglas County School District or in configuous school districts and who meets the criteria in the district charter application. The majority of the district charter school's students must reside in the school district or in configuous school districts. A charter school shall not charge mixton except to otherwise provided by taw.

A charter school proposal requires a written agreement between the charter achool authora/organizers and Douglas County School District Ro. 1, and must be sufficiented and opproved by the Board of Education. Douglas County School District Ro. 1 will follow a fair and consistent school proposal process. Establishing/munitoring/managing this process will be the responsibility of the Superintendent or designoe.
