# Workers' Compensation Authorized Treating Physician – Rule 8

The Statutory changes affecting Rule 8 requires that the employer or insured provide the injured worker with a written list of designated providers from which the injured worker may select a physician or corporate medical provider. **Effective April 1, 2015.**

Some additional information you should know, if you are injured on the job: An injured employee has the right to make a one-time change from an employer's list of authorized providers by giving notice within 90 days of the injury, but before he/she reaches maximum medical improvement.

The injured employee must request the change of medical provider in writing by submitting an approved Division of Workers' Compensation Form to the following parties:

- The Current Treating Physician
- The requesting treating Physician (this physician must be on the employer's designated provider list).
- The employer's authorized representative. The workers' compensation administrator.
